## COVID-19 Self-Screening

Grove Park Home continues to get daily updates from the Ministry of Health and other agencies. The **Best Practice for Long Term Care Homes is the self-screening procedure below:**

- If you have a fever and/or acute respiratory illness  
\* Including common cold, pharyngitis, bronchitis, pneumonia) **and**
- Travel history to China, Hong Kong, Iran, Singapore, Japan, Italy or South Korea in the last 14 days since the onset of illness **or**
- Contact with a person who has the above travel history who is ill
